How to pay the subscription: You can pay your subscription via PayPal (using the Internet) or by mail (using cheque, bank draft, postal order, etc). PayPal is especially suitable for non-UK members, because it automatically takes care of currency conversion. You do not need an account with PayPal—you just pay with a credit or debit card. However, if you pay via PayPal, we do make a small surcharge (about 6%) to cover the additional cost to the Society (but you save on postage, fees for bank drafts, etc).

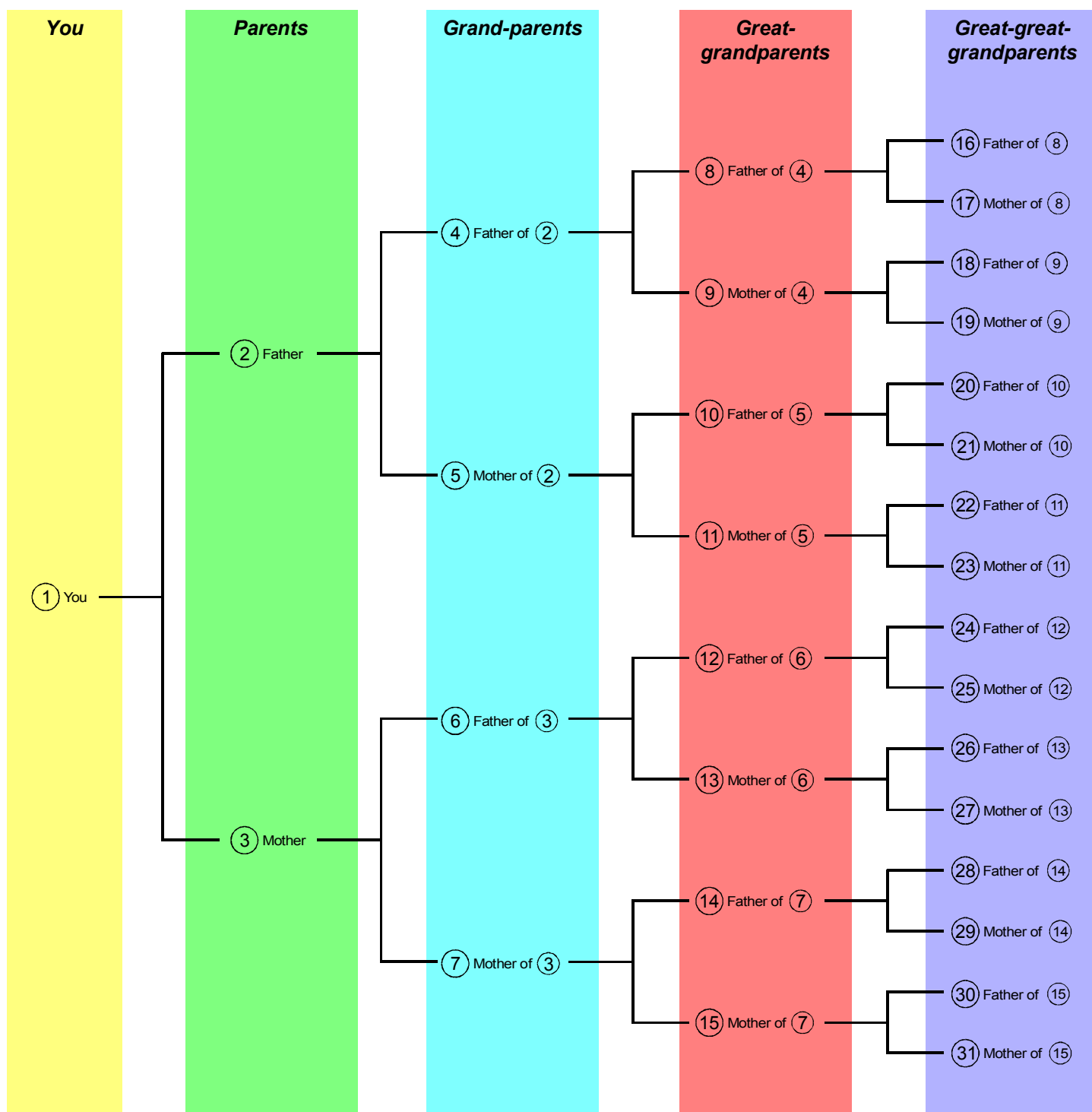
Ancestry (pedigree) chart

Just leave out what you do not know. If you can give precise dates, rather than just the year, please do so and please use the *name* of a month rather than its number. For example: 10 Aug 1882 or Aug 10 1882. This avoids confusion between the European and American conventions for writing dates.

The chart below can be used as a key to the following pages. The entry for each individual is numbered, starting with yourself as number one. The number assigned to any person's father is always twice that assigned to the person themselves. Likewise, the number assigned to any person's mother is always one more than that for his/her father. The colours are just used to distinguish between the entries for different generations.
